## JJMDC Capabilities\*

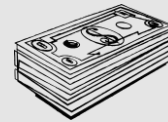
- Expanded reprocessing program to include non-JJMDC devices, enabling reprocessing of several high-volume energy devices previously only available for purchase from the OEM
